



### Licence to reproduce copyright work

#### BACKGROUND:

- (A) The Owner is the author of a work called \_\_\_\_\_ (the "Work") and retains all copyright in the same.
- (B) The Licensee wishes to acquire the right to make a limited number of copies of the Work for its personal use or the use of its students, lecturers, employees or other persons as permitted by this licence.
- (C) The number of hardcopies permitted to be produced by this licence (in addition to the Licensee's master copy as permitted by this licence) is \_\_\_\_\_.

#### AGREEMENT:

##### 1. Definitions and interpretation

In this Licence:

"**Intellectual Property Rights**" means all intellectual property rights wherever in the world, whether registered or unregistered, including any application or right of application for such rights (and the "intellectual property rights" referred to above include copyright and related rights, moral rights, database rights, confidential information, trade secrets, know-how, business names, trade names, trade marks, service marks, passing off rights, unfair competition rights, patents, petty patents, utility models, semi-conductor topography rights and rights in designs);

"**Licence Fee**" the sum of £\_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_ pounds);

"**Rights**" means the rights:

- (a) to copy the Work by downloading it from the Owner's designated website or by such other electronic means as the Owner agrees for the purpose of storage of one copy as a master copy on the Licensee's computer system;
- (b) to produce the permitted number of hardcopies of the Work;

- (c) to issue, free of charge, those hardcopies of the Work to the Licensee's students lecturers and/or employees only for their personal use. Not more than one copy may be provided to any such person unless by way of a replacement for a lost or damaged hardcopy.

For the avoidance of doubt such Rights do NOT include any right to make any more than the permitted number of hardcopies, to make any electronic copies (other than one master copy for the exercise of the Licensee's rights under this licence), to sell or licence the Work, to distribute the Work to members of the public or otherwise publish it except as expressly provided above, or to make any adaptation of the Work.

**2. Term**

This licence will come into force on the date of it and will continue in force until the earlier of the expiration of copyright in the Work or the production of the maximum permitted number of hardcopies of the Work, unless and until earlier terminated in accordance with clause 5.

**3. Consideration and grant of Rights**

In consideration for the payment by the Licensee to the Owner of Licence Fee plus VAT (if applicable) the Owner grants to the Licensee a licence to exercise the Rights in accordance with the terms and conditions of this licence.

**4. Licensee's Obligations**

- 4.1 The Licensee must ensure that the electronic master copy of the Work made by it as permitted by this licence is kept secure and only accessed for the purpose of the exercise of the copying rights granted by this licence and is irretrievably deleted in the event of this licence being terminated or upon the permitted number of copies having been made unless a new licence is entered into for further copying rights.
- 4.2 The Licensee must also ensure that all copies of the work made by it are complete and unedited without modified and carry the full copyright statement, including the name of the Owner as the author of the Work, as contained in the master copy made available to the Licensee or as may be amended on notice by the Owner to the Licensee during the term of this licence.

**5. Termination**

The Owner may terminate this licence at any time on notice to the Licensee in the event that the Licence commits any breach of the terms of this Licence, including but not limited to making or distributing any copies of the Work at a charge or other than for the purpose permitted by this licence.

**6. Law**

This Licence and any disputes relating to it, including the interpretation or construction of this licence, or relating to its subject matter shall be governed by English law and the parties agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts in all matters relating to it.
